

Special Schedule- SAT School Day- Wednesday, September 23rd

Next Wednesday, September 23rd, will be the SAT School Day for students in Grade 12. Students who have registered will come to NHS to take this standardized test. Test-takers will be marked “exempt” for the school day and for their assignments.

Students in Grades 9, 10 and 11 will not report to school on September 23rd. It will be a **remote learning** day for these students. The day will remain a Beta day on the calendar, and it will be an A day. Students will have assignments from their period 1A and 2A teachers while testing is being administered. Students are expected to complete these assignments for their period 1A and period 2A classes prior to 1:30 PM. After 1:30 pm, these students will have the opportunity to meet with their teachers for conferences through Google Meet.

Period 1A conferences are scheduled from 1:30-2:05.

Period 2A conferences are scheduled from 2:10-2:45.

Thursday, September 24th, will be a Beta Day, and it will be a B day.

PSAT Registration for Grades 9, 10 and 11

The PSAT is a standardized test that helps students prepare for the SAT. This year, the PSAT is **optional** for students. The test is **in-person**, and there is no remote option.

- Students **must** wear a mask throughout the duration of the test.
- Students who take the test will be marked “exempt” from their two classes for the day.
- Students who register for testing will be in a classroom with no more than **12 students** in a room.

Dates:

On **Wednesday, October 7th**, we will be offering the **PSAT 9** in-person at Norwalk High School for students in **Grade 9**.

On **Wednesday, October 14th**, we will be offering the PSAT/NMSQT in-person at Norwalk High School for students in **Grade 11**.

On **Thursday, October 29th**, we will be offering the **PSAT 10** in-person at Norwalk High School for students in **Grade 10**.

Time:

Students who register for PSAT testing must report to school by **8:30 AM**. Following the test, students will have lunch from 12:15-12:45 and then students will be dismissed at **1:00 PM**.

Who reports to school?

The students who will report to school on these dates are students who register for the PSAT in the specific grade level. There will be assignments that students at home will complete.

What is the schedule at home?

On Wednesday, October 7th, students will be given assignments in the morning from their period 1B and 2B teachers while testing is being administered.

On Wednesday, October 14th, students will be given assignments in the morning from their period 3B and 4B teachers while testing is being administered.

On Thursday, October 29th, students will be given assignments in the morning from their period 3A and 4A teachers while testing is being administered.

Period 1B, 3B and 3A conferences are scheduled from 1:00-1:50 on each test day.

Period 2B, 4B and 4A conferences are scheduled from 1:55-2:45 on each test day.
