Dear NHS Families,

On Wednesday, March 21, students in grade 11 will take the SAT as our district's statewide assessment. The SAT, administered by the College Board, is a standardized test and is used for college admissions and merit-based scholarships. The essay portion will not be administered as a part of the Connecticut school day SAT state assessment. The test is free of charge to all NHS students.

**Students in grade 11 should arrive to school at 7:30 am; students in grade 9, 10 and 12 should arrive by 11:30 am. Freshman, sophomores and seniors who ride the bus should be at their usual bus stops 4 hours after their usual times.**

Before and after the test, your child can strengthen essential skills and knowledge with free, personalized practice on Khan Academy (See <https://www.khanacademy.org/sat>).

3<sup>rd</sup> lunch 12:35 – 1:05


**Period 2b** 1:10 – 1:28 (18 minutes)
