Dear NHS Families,

On Wednesday, March 27, students in grade 11 will take the SAT as our district’s statewide assessment. The SAT, administered by the College Board, is a standardized test and is used for college admissions and merit-based scholarships. The essay portion will not be administered as a part of the Connecticut school day SAT state assessment. The test is free of charge to all NHS students.

**Students in grade 11 should arrive to school no later than 7:30 a.m.; students in grade 9, 10 and 12 should arrive by 11:30 a.m. Freshman, sophomores and seniors who ride the bus should be at their usual bus stops 4 hours after their usual times.**


Before and after the test, your child can strengthen essential skills and knowledge with free, personalized practice on Khan Academy (See <https://www.khanacademy.org/sat> ). Directions on how to **link a Khan Academy account to SAT** results can be found on the NHS homepage.

In advisory on **March 14 and March 21**, students in grade 11 will be completing their pre-administration information. This year, students can select up to four schools in which College Board will send their scores for free. Please review schools with your children prior to this date to be familiar with the codes and schools. (<https://portal.ct.gov/-/media/SDE/Student-Assessment/sendSATscores.pdf?la=en>)

After testing, students will follow the **B Day** schedule below:

- Period 1B** 11:35- 1:05
  - 1<sup>st</sup> lunch 11:35 - 12:05
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> lunch 12:05 - 12:35
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> lunch 12:35 – 1:05
- Period 2B** 1:10 – 1:28 (18 minutes)
- Period 3B** 1:33 – 1:51 (18 minutes)
- Period 4B** 1:56 – 2:15 (19 minutes)

Dismissal for all students will be at 2:15 PM.
