Studies routinely show that the *summer slide*, students regressing from progress made during the year, can be reduced through summer enrichment programs and summer reading.

Students who are empowered to choose their own books are much more likely to enjoy their reading and to continue the act of reading as a life-long interest. We have made several changes to the NECA summer reading program for the summer of 2016 to reflect these beliefs. Students will be required to choose two (2) books that are grade appropriate, complete notes on their chosen texts, and be prepared to discuss and write about those books in class.
