Regarding: AP EXAM REGISTRATION

Dear AP Students and Parents/ Guardians of AP Students,

You are currently registered for one or more AP courses. This rich and rewarding experience will provide you with the tools that will serve you well throughout your college career and beyond. The AP exam, for which all students are expected to register and sit, will be offered from May 6-17, 2019. Students scoring a 3 or better on an AP exam (on a scale of 1-5) may receive credit for the equivalent course at one or more of the 3,000 colleges and universities that award credit for Advanced Placement. The information below includes important details about the AP exam registration process.

Exam Registration/Deadlines

All students seeking to take an AP exam this spring must register online using the Total Registration website: www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/070580.

This year's online AP registration will begin on **Monday September 24, 2018 and end on October 19th, 2018**. The cost of taking the exam is \$98 per exam. Students currently registered with the free/reduced lunch program receive a reduced rate of \$50 per exam. The late registration period will begin on **October 20th 2018 and end on November 2nd 2018**. A \$5 late fee will be assessed per late exam registration. *It is imperative that you adhere to the deadlines, as no extensions will be granted and the registration site will no longer be active.*

Registration Payment

NHS is excited to offer families the ability to pay their exam fees online using a credit or debit card at the time of registration. Families who prefer to pay by check or money order may do so by mailing the payment, along with the **Payment Stub pdf**, to Total Registration. Checks should be made payable to **Total Registration, LLC** and include the reference number. Students should retain a copy of the registration confirmation form in the rare situation that a discrepancy occurs. Registration is not complete until payment is submitted online **or** by mail. Limited financial assistance exists for AP exam costs. If you believe you or your family qualifies for financial assistance, please contact Ms. Denke (in D House or via email: denker@norwalkps.org) to inquire whether funds are available.

Attendance and AP Exams

Students will receive an authorized absence in their scheduled classes while taking their exams, which will not count towards their total number of absences. If a student wishes to leave after a morning exam or come in late before an afternoon exam, he/she must submit a signed attendance note from a parent guardian to the house office the day of his/her exam to receive an excused absence for missed class time.


Exam Calendar for NHS

The 2019 AP Exams will be administered this year from **Monday, May 6, 2018 to Friday, May 17, 2019**. The late-testing exam period will take place from Wednesday, May 22nd through Friday, May 24th. Only students taking exams scheduled for the same time slot may take an alternative form of a particular exam during the late-testing period. If a student tests late, there may be an additional fee, grade reports may be delayed up to a month, and the free-response booklet for that particular exam will not be available. There are no make-up exams; you must arrive on time and bring all necessary materials with you.
